

Easy tour (7,7 km) - duration about 2 hours



Family - Footpath

The footpath starts at the tourist- information office Melk and leads to the town- hall square along the Stern Lane, where you pass the old parochial house (the former mainstreet of Melk). Afterwards you get to the Kremser Street, passing the old Hubbrücke (bridge). Turn right and go along the B1- Street until you reach the petrol station. Turn left into the bike lane along the Wachauer Street (right to the Danube) until you come to the mouth of the river Pielach. After you have crossed the bridge you have to turn right into a wonderful woodpath (along The Stone- wall lefthandside, following the Jacobs- trail.) At the end of that path you have to turn right until you come to the brass band hall and the children`s playground. Righthandside you will find a wood-bridge leading over the river Pielach. Then you have to turn right into the Pielamunder Allee. After 40m you have to turn left into the Mühlbachweg (country- lane). When you reach the B1- Street opposite the joiner`s workshop Lagler, you have to keep to the left until you come to the building market Hagebau Schubert. There you cross the street at the pedestrian crossing light and you go through under a bridge. Afterwards turn left into the Adlmanseder Street passing the Forstinger- and Hofer market to the Wiener Street. If you turn right you have got two possibilities for a rest (The Panorama- restaurant at the public open- air bath lefthandside or Walter`s snack bar righthandside.) Going on you will reach the city of Melk. At house number 22 you have to turn left into the Zagelauer Lane (old city wall) until you come back to the tourist- information office.
