



SCHALLABURG - FOOTHPATH

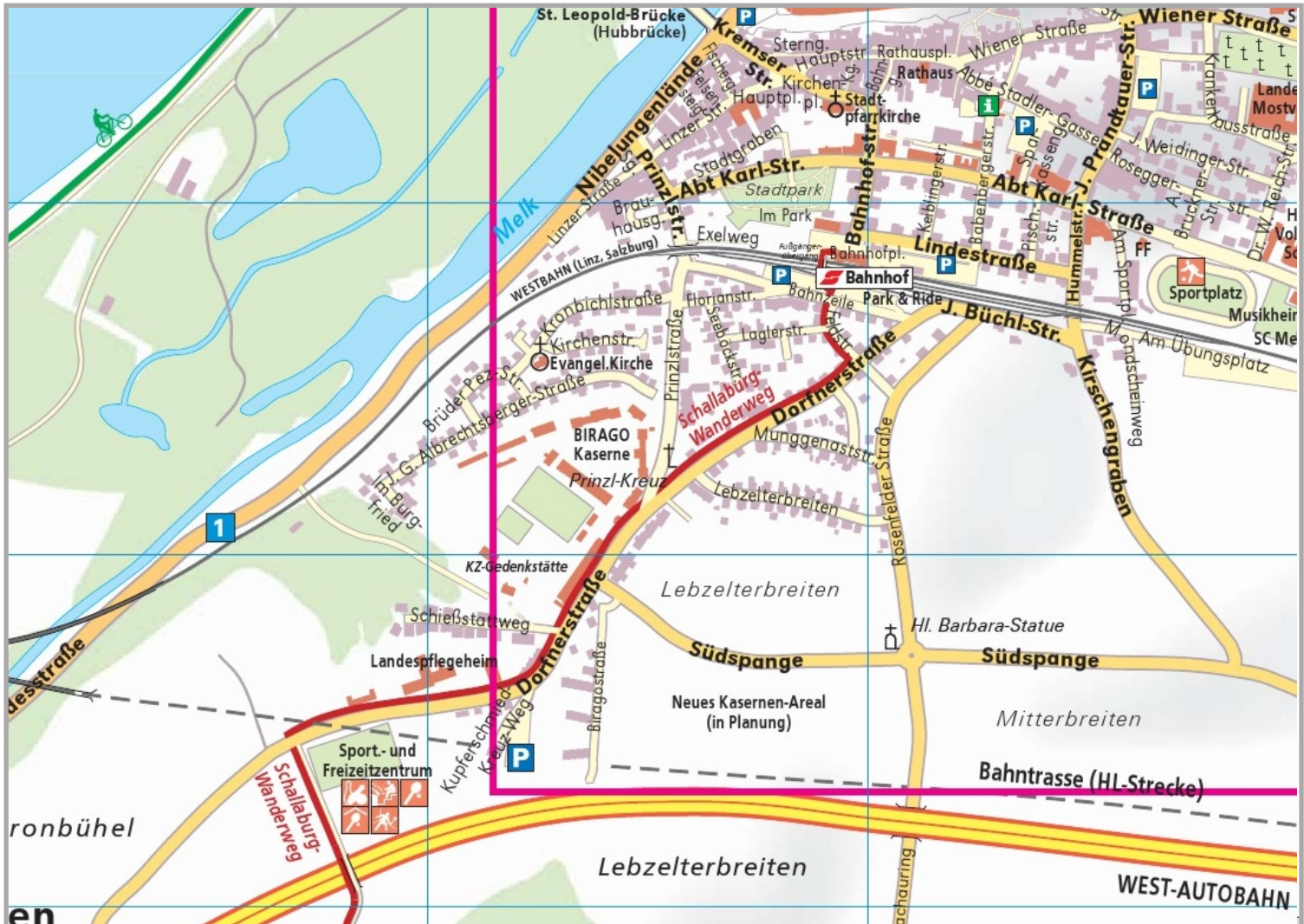
Easy family tour - duration 2,5 hours

We start at the tourist- office, turning lefthandside along the Babenberger Street to the railwaystation of Melk. Now we go along the foot-bridge over the railway (Westbahn) and then we follow the Field Street. Afterwards we turn right into the Dorfner Street, passing the military barracks and the nursing home till the end of Melk at the tennis- hall. Now we turn lefthandside over a bridge across the motorway which leads us to the Kupferschmied - cross. Straight ahead we follow an asphalt road, a short left-turn and at the following road- fork (righthandside) we walk up on a gravel- road till we reach the beginning of a wood. There we have a wonderful view of Maria Taferl, Ostrong, the castle of Artstetten, the parish- church of Leiben and the ruin of Weitenegg. Going up the wood we pass the Fürst- cross and after this wood we go along a country road that leads to a street. We turn right, go along the street, pass a crossing, but then we have to turn left into a wood, again. After the wood we walk along a field- road. Keeping to the right we come down on an asphalt-road into the village of Pöverding. On the village- road we reach the chapel. Then we turn right and pass a few farms until we go on lefthandside to the following farm.

We turn right and go up a forest- street. On top of the wood we follow a red- white marked footpath that leads us to the Schallaburg, too. There we come to the south- side of the wood where we pass a big sand- pit. Then we keep to the left on a field- path. On an asphalt lane we reach the village of Anzendorf. We go into the village (keep to the right) and pass an inn. There we go up to the famous Schallaburg.

If you don` t want to go back again you can use the shuttle- service near the entrance of the castle leading back to the railway-station of Melk.
